A FIFO system (first in, first addressed) must be used, a paper copy of the order should be kept. All orders should be checked after they are finished by Bill, Vaughn or Lonnie and so annotated on the order.

Drain boxes will have to be installed in Mayrant Bluff so that water does not flood under the units and to alleviate flooding of the parking lots.

Butler Roofing will have to return to address the problems on the new roofs.

Beach House - When the beach house is rented or being used by a member for a private meeting, the occupant's right to privacy must be respected.

The Regime has purchased a bench honoring Phyllis Jones and it has been placed near Lonnie's unit. Lonnie thanked everyone for their support and patience during this trying time.

Termite Report - The termite report must be addressed and with special note of some of the units with downstairs bedrooms that have dryer vents that do not vent correctly.

ADJOURNMENT: A motion to adjourn was made, seconded and carried.
