

## FUTURE PROJECTS for which DONATIONS ARE NEEDED

- Refurbish two ten-inch Columbiad cannons currently at Battery White;
- Create a gun carriage, representing the appearance of the original, using similar-to-original materials for walls and deck for the gun emplacement, to mask the cement support in place;
- Installation of the National Park Service-style pedestal information display;
- Submit National Register of Historic Places application for the Harvest Moon sunken wreck site in Winyah Bay across from Battery White;
- Submit National Register of Historic Places application for the right flank and rear battery sites for inclusion in the existing registry, or a new submission if necessary;
- Provide additional signage that identifies locations of barracks, cavalry stables, right flank and rear South Island Road battery;
- Improve the Battery White Map (circa 1961) to reflect traverses, gun emplacements, etc.;
- Identify persons stationed at Battery White -- based on letters, pictures, and beneficiary records at the South Carolina Department of History and Archives -- and develop a display for the mini-museum;
- Reseed grass and maintain grounds to encourage a natural cover growth supporting preservation of the earth mounds;
- Continue to offer Boy Scouts of America and other community organization project opportunities supporting preservation and educational benefits;
- Work with South Carolina Battlefield Preservation Trust to identify potential archaeological or similar projects for educational benefit.
